



## Table Stand: Power Cord & Globe Height Adjustment

### Tool Needed: #2 Phillips screwdriver

#### Unplug First

- Turn your Barava light off and unplug it from the wall, it is best practice to wait for the light to cool.

#### Access the Cord Clamp at the bottom end of the table stand.

*\*It is best to have another person help you. A second set of hands makes this adjustment easier.*

- Set your light up on a soft surface or towel
- Locate the two small Phillips screws holding the cord clamp.

#### Loosen and Adjust

- Slide the rubber cord grommet out of the top of the tube stand and slide it down the cord
- Have your helper hold the Barava globe.
- Loosen the two screws a few turns (you do not have to completely remove them).
- Hold the stand firmly while your helper holds the Globe.
- Pop the cord clamp out of the end of the table stand and gently pull the cord to the desired height:
  - Pull more cord through to **raise** the height of the light.
  - Feed cord back in to **lower** the height of the light.

#### Tighten and Test

*\*The cord clamp has serrations to grip the cord. You do not need to over tighten the screws for it to hold.*

- Hold the cord clamp in place and gently tighten the screws until snug.
- Push the cord clamp & gromet back into their respective end(s) of the stand.
- Plug it back in, and confirm everything is secure and at the desired height.
- Done, now enjoy!
